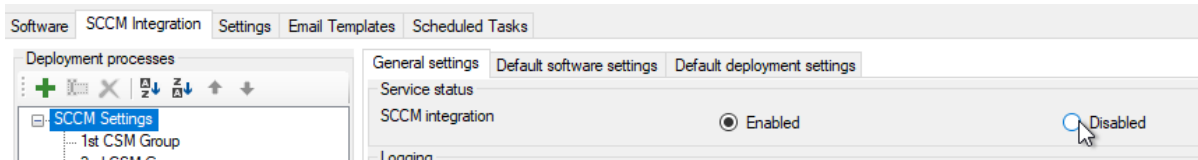

If you want to move CSM to another server in an existing SCCM environment, or if you follow the instructions to set up a completely new SCCM environment, you can install CSM for SCCM into the new environment with [these instructions](#).

Existing server

1. Disable the service from SCCM Integration tab and press Apply.



2. If you want to use the same deployment processes and their settings, copy the following files to a temporary location on a new server
 - C:\ProgramData\Centero\Software Manager\SCCM\SCCM.xml
 - C:\ProgramData\Centero\Software Manager\Software Manager.xml
 - C:\ProgramData\Centero\Software Manager\PackageDownloader\PackageDownloader.xml

New server

Make sure the new server meets the [prerequisites](#). You can use the same user account and file share as previously.

1. [Download and install CSM for SCCM](#).
2. [Open CSM for SCCM and go through the initial wizard](#). Choose **"No, I start automatic deployments manually later"**, at the last step.
3. Close the CSM for SCCM after it opens up automatically.
4. Copy the following files to the new server
 - C:\ProgramData\Centero\Software Manager\SCCM\SCCM.xml
 - C:\ProgramData\Centero\Software Manager\Software Manager.xml
 - C:\ProgramData\Centero\Software Manager\PackageDownloader\PackageDownloader.xml
5. Launch CSM for SCCM from the start menu and check if all the configurations are valid.
6. Enable the SCCM integration from SCCM Integration tab and press Apply.
