## SM for WSUS

1. Remove the CSM for WSUS service from your system. CSM for WSUS does not have a removal or installation approval, so you have to do it the other way around like it is done in the following [article](#). After doing this, any applications brought by CSM will not be published to WSUS.

2. Go to **Control Panel\Programs\Programs and Features**, select **Centero Software Manager** and uninstall it.

□

3. Go to **Control Panel\Programs\Programs and Features**, select **Centero Agent** and uninstall it.

4. Terminate the CSM for WSUS service by going to <https://preview.portal.centero.fi>, Administration - Services.

**⚠** Make sure that you have a plan for updating or removing the **CSM supported apps** from endpoints. All the applications distributed with CSM service have their built-in update system disabled. This means that if you have no other tool or method to update the apps they will not get updated.
