

Deployment Process Overview

Deployment processes are the key feature of CSM for Intune. With a deployment process, you can set deployment target groups and set deployment schedule for the application(s) selected to the deployment process.

You can configure deployment processes in [Centero Portal](#) by navigating to **Services -> CSM for Intune -> Administration -> Deployment processes** page.
